Designed as a solution to allow visitors on the Thea Foss waterway esplanade in Tacoma, WA, to see Tacoma's Museum of Glass or the waterway reversely. By shifting the back, the bench is unique and movable, allowing the user to face either direction.





Thea Foss Collection

- Ductile cast iron end frames and thermally modified hardwood slats; other wood options include Douglas Fir, Red Cedar, Ipe, and recycled plastic lumber
- Easily reversible back allows user to choose which direction to face
